Lidl Refurbishment & Bakery Extension, Sligo

Description

This project involved the complete refurbishment and bakery extension to an existing Lidl Store, Cranmore Lane, Co. Sligo.

The project consisted of constructing a new bakery to the side elevation of the store, with sand/cement render finish and paralon flat roof. Removal of old cladding to all elevations and installing new cladding, removal of existing external & internal windows & doors and installing new curtain walling, entrance pod, steel and timber doors. The existing ceilings were removed, and new ceilings installed in the store and warehouse. The walls of the store were plastered & tiled with existing finished blockwork re-painted. New crash barriers, night cage and bump rails were installed. The existing floors were re-tiled. Existing mechanical and electrical services were removed and new systems installed. A new trolley bay was constructed, new external crash barriers & bollards installed, and new bin store constructed. A new trolley keeper duct was installed around the perimeter of the site and the car park was re-tared, new line marking carried out and new street lighting installed.

The above works involved close liaison with the client as the works were carried out in a live environment and a strong relationship was built and maintained during the project leading to a successful conclusion with the project being carried out on time and within budget.
