

## Local Authority Housing, Raheen, Athenry, Galway

## Description

The project involved the development of a housing estate of 50 no. Social & Affordable Housing Units of various styles, terraced, semi-detached and detached. for Galway County Council in Athenry and associated works, including an ancillary road joining regional roads along the site. Within the site itself there are various roads and associated civil works. The ancillary road was divided into two phases. The site road contains approximately 2,300 m<sup>2</sup> of 80 mm macadam, along with 1500m<sup>2</sup> of paved parking bays and the ancillary road is approximately 2,800 m<sup>2</sup> of 210 mm macadam.

The landscaping works on this project included both hard and soft landscaping.

As well as seeding the green areas of the housing development, trees were planted at the entrance to the estate, public open spaces and to private gardens of the houses. Shelter planting was used around the gas tank storage area and I the open spaces. Tree surgery works, by specialist contractors, had to be carried out to existing trees. A sustainable urban drainage system called Aquaflow permeable paving was used on the driveways of the houses. This system allows the rainwater to infiltrate through a permeable lock paving surface into a unique sub-base before being released in a controlled manner in to the water courses.
