

## Medtronic Customer Innovation Centre, Galway

This award winning development consisted of the construction to the North East of the existing Medtronic Building 2 of a new two storey extension (2,498m²) over a partial basement, as well as the fit out of the building. Central to this is a Customer Innovation Centre containing meeting rooms and a research and development suite.

## Sustainability

Medtronic Customer Innovation Centre has been registered under LEED 2009 for New Construction and Major Renovation to verify the Project's sustainability credentials. The project received a LEED Gold certification by the US Green Building Council. NSAI carried out Environmental Audit I.S. EN ISO 14001:2004 on the 27th July '12 and noted that " Significant improvements have been made to the systematic integration of EMS controls within core business and site management through adoption of LEED principles in a systematic manner ". We received the Irish Building & Design Award 2014 for Sustainable/ Green Project of the Year for this project. It is estimated that the combination of all energy efficient features within the building will result in a 20% energy saving when compared to a standard (non LEED Gold) building design.



The building was fitted out to contain, on the ground floor, a central atrium with a reception area, luggage store, kitchenette and interactive communication hub, surrounded by a Customer Innovation Centre containing meeting rooms, a research and development suite and ancillary facilities and on the first floor, further meeting rooms, cellular and open plan offices and support facilities, with plant in the partial basement.
