



Medtronic Customer Innovation Centre, Galway

This award winning development consisted of the construction to the North East of the existing Medtronic Building 2 of a new two storey extension (2,498m²) over a partial basement, as well as the fit out of the building. Central to this is a Customer Innovation Centre containing meeting rooms and a research and development suite.

Sustainability

Medtronic Customer Innovation Centre has been registered under LEED 2009 for New Construction and Major Renovation to verify the Project's sustainability credentials. The project received a LEED Gold certification by the US Green Building Council. NSAI carried out Environmental Audit I.S. EN ISO 14001:2004 on the 27th July '12 and noted that "Significant improvements have been made to the systematic integration of EMS controls within core business and site management through adoption of LEED principles in a systematic manner". We received the Irish Building & Design Award 2014 for Sustainable/ Green Project of the Year for this project. It is estimated that the combination of all energy efficient features within the building will result in a 20% energy saving when compared to a standard (non LEED Gold) building design.

The building was fitted out to contain, on the ground floor, a central atrium with a reception area, luggage store, kitchenette and interactive communication hub, surrounded by a Customer Innovation Centre containing meeting rooms, a research and development suite and ancillary facilities and on the first floor, further meeting rooms, cellular and open plan offices and support facilities, with plant in the partial basement.
