



Scott Building at Midland Regional Hospital, Tullamore

The project involved the refurbishment of the existing Scott Building Co. Offaly of c. 5,800m² over 4 storeys. The works comprised of a full strip out and demolition works including the removal of mechanical and electrical installations followed by a full refurbishment. The building is a protected structure.

The following accommodation was provided within an existing building:

- Mental Health Centre and associated workshops and supports including the Mental Health
- Sector Headquarters
- Office Accommodation and Meeting Rooms for Administration staff
- Education and Training Centre
- On-Call and Office Accommodation for Hospital Management and staff.

The project consisted of restoration works to some areas of the existing stonework fabric and to the existing main entrance area. We maintained an existing listed stairwell and incorporated a high finish toughened glass balustrading to same.
