



Edenwood House, Cricklewood

Nestled in the heart of Cricklewood, just moments away from Central London, Eden NW2 stands as a distinguished urban gem. Embracing a seamless blend of vintage and modern aesthetics inspired by the iconic former Galtymore Ballroom, these apartments offer an exquisite backdrop for an elevated lifestyle.

Eden NW2 is a premier mixed-use development located at the junction of Cricklewood Broadway and Depot Approach, comprising 95 contemporary apartments arranged around a landscaped courtyard above a double-height retail space anchored by Waitrose. The five-storey scheme delivers 261 bed spaces across a mix of one-, two- and three-bedroom homes, alongside extensive resident amenities including a lounge, workspace, cinema room and communal courtyard, with 165 cycle spaces and a basement providing 117 car parking spaces for the retail component.
