




Yeats College Extension & Refurbishment

This project included the preservation, extension and refurbishment of a listed Heritage Building, unoccupied since the 1970s. The building was converted to a four storey educational facility with the addition of a four storey over basement rear extension.

Works included the internal demolition, formation of new opes, preservation of surviving features, plaster cornices, limestone lime plaster and timber sash windows, fit-out works and associated siteworks were all completed within a confined operational area and a new structural steel frame was installed to support the roof and support the new intermediate frame levels.
