The ground floor main reception has a children's play area complete with seating. The facility is fully enabled for disabled access including platform lifts and induction audible loops for persons with hearing impairments. The car park contains 52 car parking spaces, four of which are wheelchair accessible and four patient and child spaces, in addition, an ambulance bay with a charge point is also provided.
