Works will comprise of 120 bed National Forensic Hospital, a 10 bed Forensic Child and Adolescent Mental Health Unit, a 10 bed Forensic Mental Health Intellectual Disability Unit and a 30 bed Intensive Care Rehabilitation Unit totalling approximately 24,000 sq.m of floor area, all within a single campus. The NFMHS Hospital campus has been designed to facilitate segregated high and medium secure services and includes a number of shared facilities. It will include 13 hospital wards, a primary healthcare & therapy centre and administrative complex.
